This tender is an e-tender and is being published online for_Competitive Bids are invited from Public/Private Sector Insurance Companies/Banks and their subsidiary Insurance Companies through their Regional Office or Divisional Office in the State of Kerala and Insurance Brokers with IRDA licensed operating offices in Kerala, for renewal of Group Health Insurance Scheme for APCOS Employees under TRCMPU Ltd. in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Alappuzha and Pathanamthitta districts. The tender is invited in two-cover system from the registered and eligible firms through e-procurement portal of Government of Kerala (https://www.etenders.kerala.gov.in). Prospective bidders willing to participate in this tender shall necessarily register themselves with above mentioned e-procurement portal. The tender time line is available in the critical date section of this tender published in www.etenders.kerala.gov.in.

A) Online Bidders registration process:

Bidders should have a Class II or above Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) to be procured from any Registration Authorities (RA) under the Certifying Agency of India. Details of RAs will be available on <u>www.cca.gov.in</u>. Once, the DSC is obtained, bidders have to register on <u>www.etenders.kerala.gov.in</u> website for participating in this tender. Website registration is a one-time process without any registration fees. However, bidders have to procure DSC at their own cost.

B) **Online Tender Process:**

The tender process shall consist of the following stages:

- i) Downloading of tender document: Tender document will be available for free download on <u>www.etenders.kerala.gov.in</u> from the date & time of publication of e-tender, till the last date & time for online submission of e-tender. However, tender document fees shall be payable at the time of bid submission as stipulated in this tender document. Downloading of tender documents will not be possible after the date specified above.
- ii) Pre-bid Meeting: NA
- iii) **Publishing of Corrigendum**: All corrigenda shall be published on <u>www.etenders.kerala.gov.in</u> and shall not be available elsewhere.
- iv) **Bid submission**: Bidders have to submit their bids along with supporting documents to support their eligibility, as required in this tender document to <u>www.etenders.kerala.gov.in</u>. No manual submission of bid is allowed and manual bids shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
- v) Opening of Technical bid and bidder short-listing: Technical bids will be opened, evaluated and shortlisted as per the eligibility and technical qualification. All documents in support of technical qualification shall be submitted (online) within the due date and time. Failure to submit the documents will attract disqualification. Bids shortlisted by this process will be taken up for opening the financial bid.
- vi) **Opening of financial bids:** Bids of the qualified bidders shall only be considered for opening and evaluation of the financial bid on the date and time mentioned in the critical date's section.

C) Documents comprising bid:

i) First Stage (Pre-qualification or Technical cover based on 1 cover or 2 cover tender system): Pre-qualification or technical proposal shall contain the scanned copies of the documents mentioned in the Terms & Conditions (Clause 1. Eligibility and qualification requirements) which every bidder has to upload.

During the online bid submission process, the bidder shall select **SBI MOPS** option and submit the page, to view the **Terms and Conditions** page. On further submitting the same, the e-Procurement system will re-direct the bidder to MOPS Gateway, where two options namely **SBI** and **Other Banks*** will be shown. Here, Bidder may proceed as per below:

a) <u>SBI Account Holders</u> shall click SBI option to with its Net Banking Facility, where bidder can enter their internet banking credentials and transfer the Tender Fee and EMD amount.
