All bids should be submitted in two parts viz. technical and commercial. The bidder shall submit the EMD amount as indicated in the tender notification in a separate cover along with the tender in the form of Demand Draft.

Thiruvananthapuram Milk Union is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme Namely National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD), as per the operational guidelines issued by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying.

Govt. of India had conveyed the Administrative Approval for implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (NPDD) with a total Project outlay of **Rs. 1356.95 Lakh** with a GOI share of **909.25 Lakh** & EIA share of 447.7 **Lakh** to TRCMPU for Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta and Alappuzha Districts for the period 2021-23.

As per the operational guidelines the implementing agency has to engage an external agency for the final evaluation of the scheme to examine the achievements and impact of the schemes implemented.

NPDD scheme support includes Milk Chilling Facilities, Establishment Laboratories, Accreditation and Certification of BMCs, Information and Communication Technology Networking, Training for Dairy staff, BMC, DCS operators, Planning and Monitoring.

As envisaged in the scheme, the TRCMPU Ltd wishes to conduct a Final evaluation of the NPDD VII (Kerala Project-12).

The study team may include specialists from different areas like Dairy Technology, Marketing, Engineering and Dairy Extension as far as possible.

The major objectives of the scheme are: -

- · To install BMCs to create additional rural milk chilling capacity.
- To improve the Methylene Blue Reduction Time (MBRT) and thereby the bacterial quality of Milk.
- · FSMS Certification and Upgrading of all Dairy Plants and selected DCS
- Establishment of in-house cloud service for ERP and traceability as per FSSAI
- · Capacity Building through Training and Awareness Programme
- · Support the R&D for futuristic strategic planning
- Strengthening the Laboratory Infrastructure & equipment for more efficient testing and traceability.

Scope of the Work

- 1.2. Note the deviations from the project outlay and explain the reasons for the deviation.
- 1.3. Physical evaluation of assets created in the schemes like Milk Chilling facilities, Establishment of Laboratories, Information & Communication Technology Networking, Manpower Development, and Planning & Monitoring on a random basis.
- 1.4. Provide a chapter on the benefits obtained by milk producers by the implementation of NPDD.
- 1.5. Provide information on how the NPDD implementation helped to strengthen the Micro financing among the rural farmer community.
- 1.6. Provide information regarding the extent of digitalization in payments with respect to the implementation of the Project.
- 1.7. Include the details about the Benefits to the Milk Union like an increase in Procurement, Processing, and Marketing facilities.

4. Reports & Time frame

Ten copies of report along with soft copy shall be submitted. The report shall contain overall study method adopted, basis of sample selection and the area selected. The report shall contain detailed finding on each component and an Executive Summary.

5. Time Frame

The assignment shall be completed within a time frame of **3 months** from the date of the Award of Work.

6. Eligibility Criteria for the Bidding Party

6.1. Work experience in a Managerial Position in a Food Industry is compulsory.

The consultancy/agency should preferably have the support of the Dairy Technologist/Engineer with Dairy/Food industrial experience in the field of Quality Control and/or Production Section/or Projects/Engineering Section working full time or part-time or on a need basis.

7. Tender Document

- 7.1. Earnest Money Deposit: The offer should be accompanied by an EMD of Rs.2,000.00 (Rupees Two Thousand only).
- 7.2. The Tender form shall, be submitted in separate Covers viz. Technical Bid & Financial Bid.
- 7.3. The Technical Bid shall contain profiles of experts, suggested methodology, the composition of study team, time frame, terms and conditions and the cost involved.

- 7.4. The Financial Bid shall contain the cost of assessment for the entire Union to meet the project guidelines.
- 7.5. The Tender Evaluation Committee shall scrutinize the Technical Bid to find among the bidders having Technical Eligibility.

8. Evaluation & Selection Process

The finalization of the consultant is based on QCBS method to identify the parties those who ensure detailed scientific and effective evaluation of the project to highlight the details of benefits to the farmers as well as to suggest the improvements needed in the project execution. The consultancy service will be awarded to the firm who has achieved the highest score in the QCBS evaluation.

Proposal with the lowest amount may be given a financial score out of 100 (Hundred) and other proposals given financial scores that are inversely proportional to their prices with respect to the lowest offer.

Similarly, proposal with the highest Technical Marks (as allotted by the evaluation committee) shall be given a score out of 100 (Hundred) and other proposals be given technical score that are proportional to their marks with respect to the highest Technical Marks. The total score, both Technical and Financial, shall be obtained by weighing the quality and cost scores and adding them up. On the basis of the combined weighted score for quality and cost, the consultant shall be ranked in terms of the total score obtained.

The proposal obtaining the highest total combined score in evaluation of quality and cost will be ranked as H-1 followed by the proposals securing lesser marks as H-2, H-3 etc. The proposal securing the highest combined marks and ranked H-1 will be invited for negotiations, if required and shall be recommended for award of contract. In the event two or more bids have the same score in final ranking, the bid with highest technical score will be H-1. In such a case, an Evaluated Bid Score (B) will be calculated for each responsive Bid using the following formula, which permits a comprehensive assessment of the Bid price and the Technical merits of each Bid:

C = Evaluated Bid Price

C low = the lowest of all Evaluated Bid Prices among responsive Bids

T = the total Technical Score awarded to the Bid

Thigh = the Technical Score achieved by the Bid that was scored best among all

responsive Bids

X = Weightage for the Price - 0.3
